



## **Emergency Medical Technician Job Description**

### **Standards of Practice:**

To provide direct patient care under the supervision of a Registered Nurse.

### **Qualifications:**

1. Complete EMT or Paramedic Training from an approved training agency.
2. Training should indicate both didactic clinical practices in lab environment and out of classroom (field/clinical) training.
3. Pass a county approved written exam.
4. Pass a county approved practical exam.
5. Be 18 years of age or older and have EMT or Paramedic license.
6. Current BCLS certification.
7. Proof of fulfillment of health screening criteria required by the state of California and Advanced Medical Placement.
8. Documented evidence of a minimum of 12 months experience within the last 36 months in the area for which applied.
9. Successful completion of the knowledge competency exams with a score of 80% or greater.
10. Successful completion of screening evaluations required for clinical areas in which the Emergency Medical Technician practices with a score of 80% or greater.

### **Functions and Responsibilities:**

1. Assist A.L.S. personnel (EMT/P/MICN/CCT) in patient care.
2. Emergency medical care and transport of the sick and injured.
3. Cooperation with other emergency response agencies and hospitals.
4. Work within the scope of practice.
5. Is supervised by the Advanced Medical Placement Director of Nursing.
6. Performs basic nursing procedures in accordance with the facility's standards and policies and procedures.
7. Maintains patient records and chart to ensure an accurate record of the patient's medical treatment.
8. Assists other members of the nursing team.
9. Maintains positive behaviors, approaches, attitude, and commitment to interpersonal service toward patients, visitors, and co-workers.
10. Demonstrates knowledge of age specific care, including but not limited to, identifying the need for additional safety measures, physiological normal values/reading: and assessing skin integrity, behavior, motor skills and/or activities that place patients at risk as well as communicates effectively in a clear, concise, understandable manner. Applicable for the populations checked below:  Neonate  Infant  Toddler  Preschool child  School aged child  Adolescent  Young adult  Adult  Elderly  Late elderly
11. Demonstrates appropriate use of safety devices and other facility equipment.
12. Maintains safe, comfortable, and therapeutic environment for patients and families in accordance with facility standards.
13. Adheres to Advanced Medical Placement policies and procedures.

### **Physical Demands:**

1. Requires full range of body motion including lifting adult patients, manual and finger dexterity, and eye-hand-foot coordination.
2. Frequent standing and walking for extended periods of time.
3. Ability to push/pull more than 50lbs. And to lift objects greater than 20lbs.
