



## **Radiology Technician Job Description**

### **Standards of Practice:**

To provide for the protection, safety, education and comfort of patients and co-workers during the usage of X-rays, scans, CT's and other imaging tests that help diagnose numerous diseases, injuries and ailments.

### **Qualifications:**

1. Current ARRT certification in the State of California.
2. Current BCLS certification.
3. Proof of fulfillment of health screening criteria required by the state of California and Advanced Medical Placement.
4. Documented evidence of a minimum of 12 months experience within the last 36 months in the area for which applied.
5. Successful completion of the knowledge competency exams with a score of 80% or greater.
6. Successful completion of screening evaluations required for clinical areas in which the Radiology Tech. practices with score of 80% or greater.

### **Functions and Responsibilities:**

1. Is supervised by the Advanced Medical Placement Director of Nursing and/or CNO.
2. Performs X-rays, removes and processes film, and performs other imaging tests in accordance with the facility's standards, policies and procedures.
3. Maintains patient records and chart to ensure there is an accurate record of the patient's diagnostic tests/treatment using standards of confidentiality.
4. Assists other members of the healthcare team.
5. Maintains positive behaviors, approaches, attitude, and commitment to interpersonal service toward patients, visitors, and co-workers.
6. Demonstrates knowledge of age specific care, including but not limited to, identifying the need for additional safety measures, physiological normal values/reading, assessing skin integrity, behavior, motor skills and/or activities that place patients at risk as well as communicates effectively in a clear, concise, understandable manner. Applicable for the populations checked:  Neonate  Infant  Toddler  Preschool child  School aged child  Adolescent  Young adult  Adult  Elderly  Late elderly
7. Demonstrates appropriate use of radiation safety measures and protection devices and other facility equipment.
8. Maintains safe, comfortable, and therapeutic environment for patients and families in accordance with facility standards.
9. Reviews and evaluates developed x-rays, video tape, or computer generated information to determine if images are satisfactory for diagnostic purposes.
10. Notifies MD or Nurses of any change of condition of patient during diagnostic procedures or while in diagnostic suites
11. Explains procedures and provides education to patients and family as needed.
12. Adheres to Advanced Medical Placement policies and procedures.
13. Aware of all National Patient Safety Goals and performance improvement plans for required outcomes at assigned facilities.

### **Physical Demands:**

1. Requires full range of body motion including lifting adult patients, manual and finger dexterity, and eye-hand-foot coordination.
2. Frequent standing and walking for extended periods of time.
3. Ability to push/pull more than 50lbs. and to lift objects greater than 20lbs.
